2006 Platform of the 31st Legislative District Democratic Party

The platform of the 31st LD Democrats is founded on basic truths voiced in the most fundamental documents of U.S. history and law. Our responses to specific issues align with the fundamental truths stated in the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution of the United States of America.

The freedom of "We The People" is at risk today from abuse of executive, legislative and judicial power. Similar abuse of power by corporate entities caused the American Revolution of 1776. Consequently, it is important to review the philosophical and legal basis of that revolution in setting agenda for democratic actions. This is the situation of "We The People" today.
